Sara is a trained doula and a passionate advocate for maternal health and birth rights. She has worked closely with the Swiss Philanthropy Foundation, a nonprofit that helps women and children across the world live better lives, support themselves, receive an education and access needed health care services.

Along with her siblings, Sara is a Co-Founder of the Ojje Family Fund and has worked for more than a decade providing grants in eight countries in education and women's health and rights.

In 2015, Sara received her M.S. in Fundraising and Grantmaking at New York University, where she wrote her Masters thesis on the state of funding for maternal health initiatives following the conclusion of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs). Prior to this, Sara built Michael Kors' corporate social responsibility platform including a successful partnership with the World Food Programme and the "Watch Hunger Stop" campaign. She currently serves as Director of Philanthropy at Athos II Holdings, working with family offices and their next generation members on their philanthropic impact.
